PROPOSAL FOR MOWING AND TRIMMING SERVICES BID OPENING

Thursday, July 13, 2017 at 12:00 PM

1. Notice is hereby given that bids for Mowing and Trimming Services for Frankfort Community Unit School District 168, West Frankfort, IL, will be opened and read in the Administrative Service Center, 900 N. Cherry St., West Frankfort, IL, at the time and date indicated above. Contract period will begin within 30 days after acceptance by District and notice to proceed. Once the contract commences, the contract period will be for the 2017 mowing season, with options to continue the contract for the 2018 and 2019 mowing seasons.
2. The sealed bids shall be delivered to the Office of the Superintendent at 112 West Poplar Street, West Frankfort, IL, any time prior to, but not later than 12:00 PM, July 13, 2017. No proposal received after said designated time will be considered. The bidder assumes the risk of any delay in handling or delivery of mail.
3. The proposal (Exhibit A) must be submitted on the bid form provided with these specifications and must be contained in a sealed envelope which shall be endorsed on the outside thereof with the following information: Mowing Service Bid
4. All bids submitted must be valid for a minimum period up to September 15, 2017.
5. The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to accept bids either in whole or in part, and to waive any irregularities or defects in any proposal should it deem to be in the best interest of the School District to do so. The contract will be awarded, if at all, to the lowest responsible bidder meeting specifications as determined by the Board of Education. In determining same, the actual dollar cost of the proposal as submitted by each bidder will not be the sole criterion. The Board is equally concerned with the proven ability of the bidder to satisfactorily perform his contract so that the service will be provided in accordance with contract documents.
6. Each bidder may submit suggested changes in the specified work. These proposals must be submitted separately in writing, must include the cost, and must include a listing of specifications for proposed change.
7. The successful bidder shall submit evidence of compliance with the established insurance coverage including Workmen's compensation, Body Injury Liability, Property Damage Liability Insurance and Umbrella Liability Insurance as specified. Bodily injury liability insurance shall be a minimum of \$500,000 for each person and \$1,000,000 for each accident.
8. To the extent possible, it is expected that mowing would occur on weekends or school holidays to avoid populations of school children and vehicles around the buildings where mowing would take place. When weekend mowing is impossible, the mowing must take place after school is dismissed and students are not in the area.
9. This contract is subject to and governed by the rules and regulations of the Illinois Fair Employment Practices Act.
10. The successful bidder will be responsible to turn in a completed criminal background investigation and fingerprint card to the Superintendent's Office on each employee of the contractor that works at Unit District No. 168 during the term of this contract in compliance with the Illinois Revised Statutes Chapter 122, Paragraph 10.21.9 [105 ILCS 5/10-21.9]
